I love Love **LOVE** this fun fold! **THANKS SO VERY MUCH!!!** to one of my stampin' buddies, Kim Baker!!! But... be careful... **L@@@K Out!** It is very addictive!

Here are the supplies you will need. All measurements in inches. Horizontal card

Card Stock: 4-1/4 x 5-1/2, score @ 2-3/4 (across the 5-1/2) AND 1-1/4 x 6-1/2, score 1/2 from each end AND

1-1/4 x 4-1/2, score 1/2 from each end (OR 1-1/4 x 3-1/2, score 1/2 each end)

Designer Series Paper: 1 x 5-1/4 AND 1 x 3-1/4 (OR 1 x 2-1/4, score 1/2 each end)

White/Vanilla: 4 x 5-1/4, score @ 2-5/8 (across the 5-1/4) AND 2-1/2 x 4 (back of the card)

AND scrap for sentiment with coordinating CS for behind sentiment

Score Tape, bone folder, trim or ribbon

Stamps, ink, die cuts/punched items/embellishments, etc.

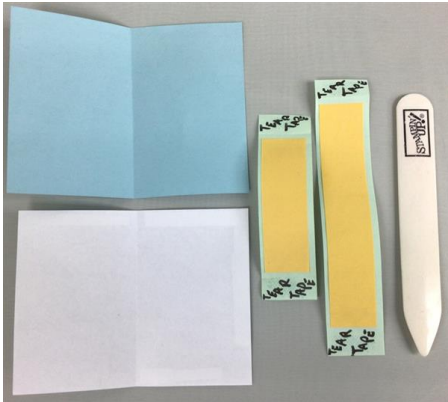

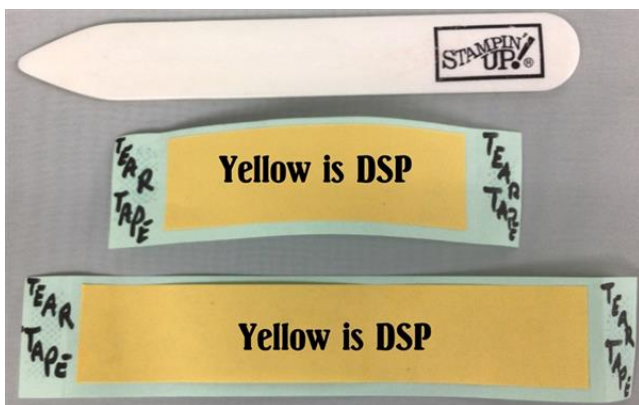

**DIRECTIONS:** (for easier to see purposes, I will be using colored copy paper)



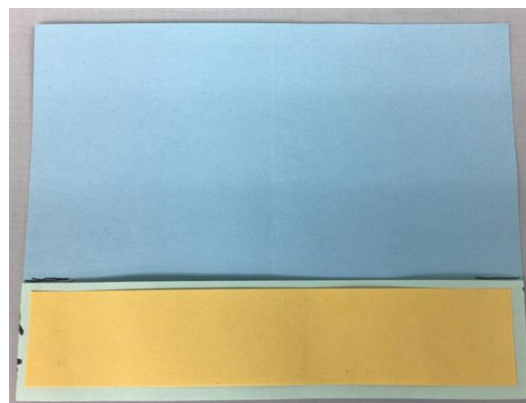
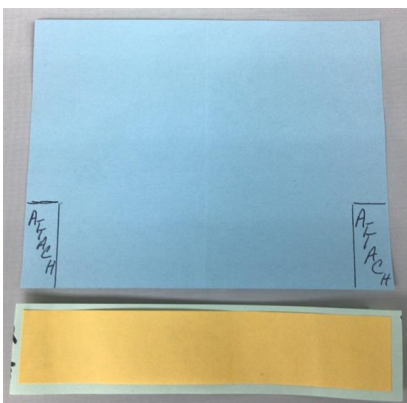
Here are your main pieces.



Attach your designer series paper to your strips of cardstock.

Take your bone folder and run it along the back side a couple of times to break the fiber (to make it "bendy").

Put tear tape on both ends of both strips.



Bend in the ends of the longer strip, remove the tear tape and attach to the FRONT of the bottom 5-1/2 x 4-1/4 layer.

Slip between the bottom strip and layer on bottom piece.

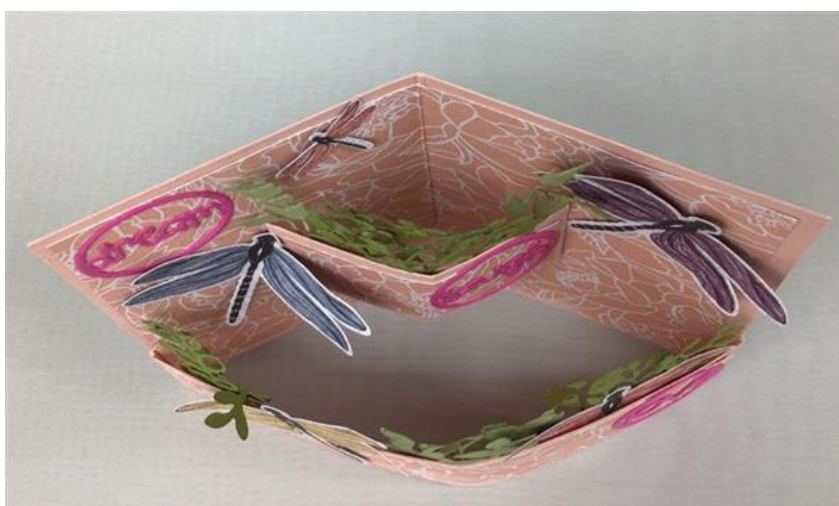
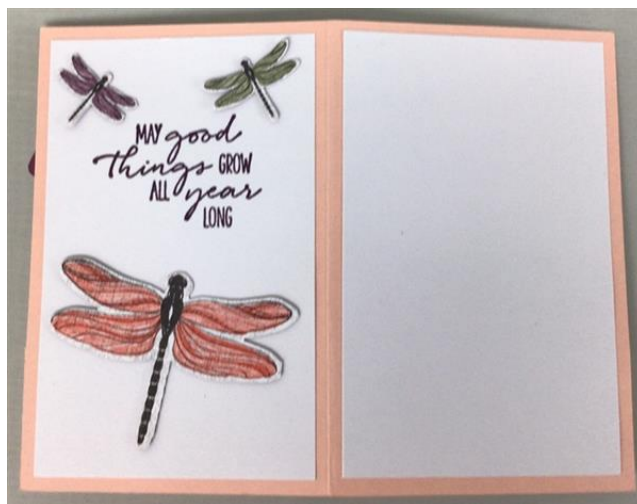
