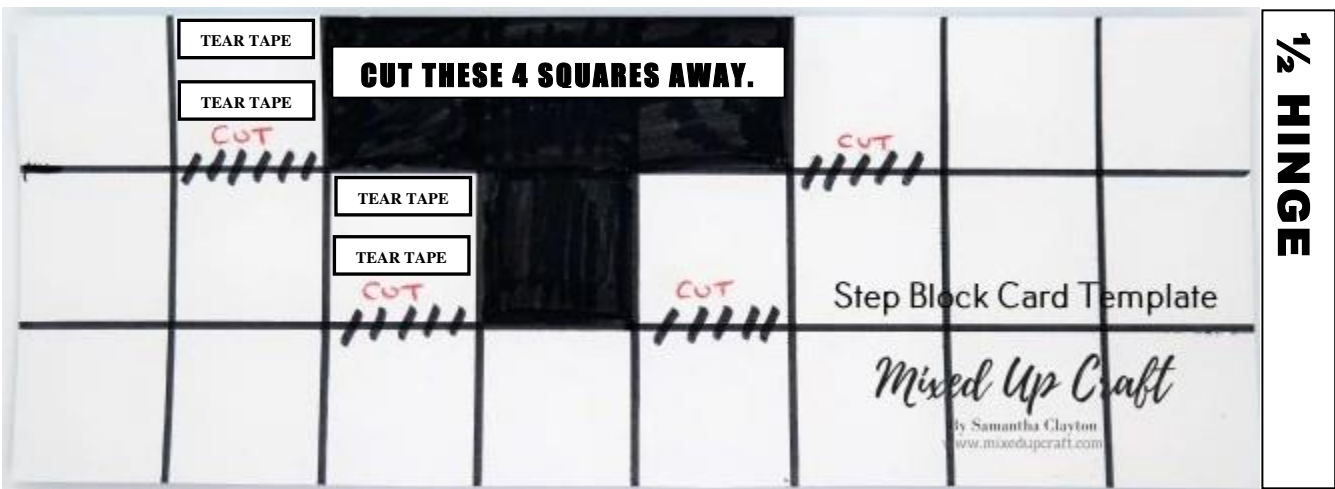


## STEP BLOCK CARD

They also fold completely flat and fit into an envelope which I made on the Envelope Punch Board.

### **SUPPLIES** (Adjusted by Nancy Legate for Technique/Fun Fold Basket Swap on 3-23-19)

1 piece of 4-1/2 x 12 cardstock for base. Score along the 12" side at 1-1/2 + 3" + 4-1/2 + 6" + 7-1/2 + 9" + 10-1/2

Score along the 4-1/2" side at 1-1/2 + 3 See the template above for the cutting directions.

1 piece of 1 x 4-1/2 cardstock for hinge, same color as base. Score at 1/2 of the 1" side. Miter 4 corners.

11 pieces of 1-3/8 x 1-3/8 cardstock for your back layers; I used black.

11 pieces of 1-1/4 x 1-1/4 pattern paper to decorate your squares. I cut 1-3/8 strips, then used smallest square of the Stitched Shapes Dies to cut out fancy layer with stitching.

1 piece of 2-11/16 square white cardstock for back for your message; layered on a piece of 2-7/8 square of black.

1 piece of 8-1/2 x 8-1/2 pattern paper for envelope on envelope punch board. Punch at 3-3/4.

Flower dies, embellishments and sentiment to decorate your card as desired.

- Butterfly duet punch
- SAB Botanical Butterfly DSP
- Stitched Shapes Framelits
- Wonderful Floral Framelits
- Envelope Punch Board
- White Envelope Paper (retired) for envelopes
