SUPPLIES:

Vertical/Portrait card

ALL measurements in inches.

White/Vanilla:

- 2 @ 5-1/2 x 8-1/2

DSP:

- 1 @ 4 x 5-1/4

SCRAPS:

- layers for greeting

Large Oval, Circle, or Square die

- my oval shown is approx. 2-5/8 w x 3-1/2 h

Other Supplies:

- die cutter machine, scorer, paper cutter
- stamps for simple background stamping
- ink, embellishments, sponge, etc.

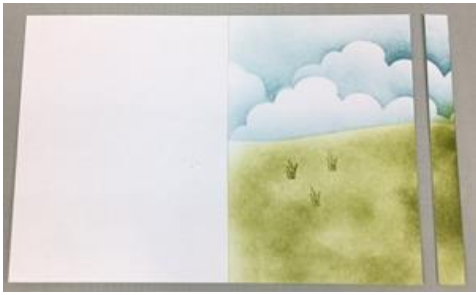

Take 1 of your 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 bases. Score @ 4-1/4. On this card I used a brush to make my background layers.



Cut 1/2 off of edge of inside of card. Short side will be the inside of card.

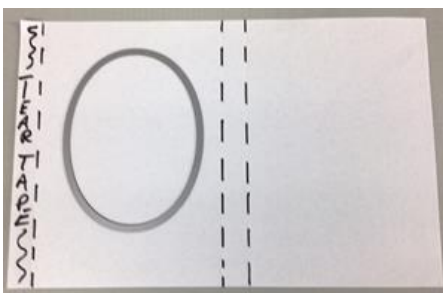


Take your other 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 base. Score @ 1/2 + 4-1/4 + 4-3/4. Cut a sliver off the 1/2 side... yes, just a sliver.



Save your oval piece for another project.

Take your die and cut out an opening in the section next to the 1/2 edge. I put mine up more towards the top.



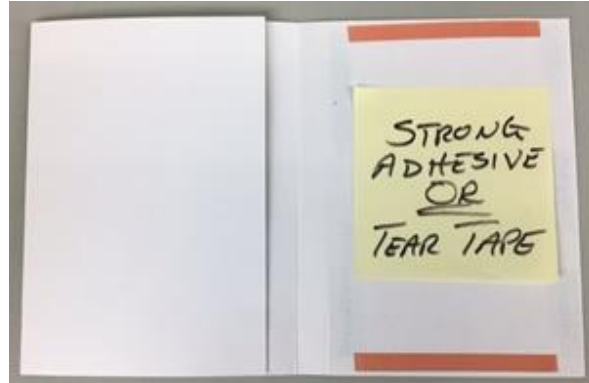
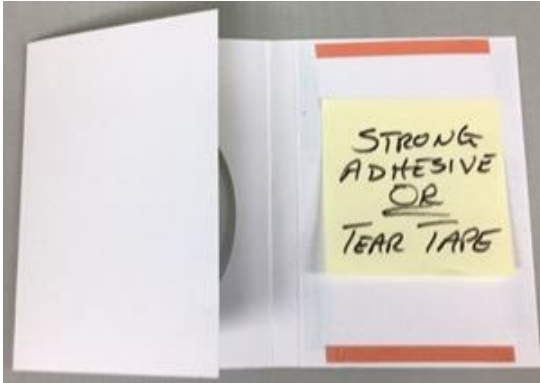
Apply tear tape or strong adhesive along the 1/2 edge.



Open your sponged card. Lay the tear tape edge upward, just to the right of the 4-1/4 score line.



Fold over the front of your card onto the tear tape.



Flip your card over from top to bottom. Apply tear tape or strong adhesive around the right section. You will see 2 each 1/2 sections next to this right section. (Mine just shows tear tape on the top and bottom as I am using removable tape on the sides for demonstration purposes during my Zoom Mystery Card.)



Now fold your far right side over even with the far left side.



Flip it back over... Wha-la!!!! You now have your Inside Shadow Box Card!
